Chairmans Report

It has not escaped me that the role chairman of the Parish Council is nothing if not varied. In recent weeks I have attended a Highways meeting with our clerk, Jackie Gallop and our now retired councillor, Rodney Downer, who I shall mention more about a little later. Highways are hoping to conduct two rounds of works in the village, probably from September onwards. The first element will be to address the fallen section of hillside opposite Appuldurcombe Road. This work will first be assessed and if it is necessary will involve the use of heavy plant. The road may be shut for quite a few weeks.



The second element will be the re-surfacing of the main road through the village. Highways intend to excavate down to a decent substrate and repair and re-lay. This work cannot be undertaken at night, neither can it be conducted on a traffic light system because of the machinery involved and the width of the road. This work will commence at the Clarence Road end of the village and section by section make its way back as far as Cooks Castle. This work will also require the road being closed. We can expect some disruption. I should say that either element may not go ahead - it is their hope that

it will.

I received correspondence from a concerned resident about the amount of litter hidden behind a wall in Clarence Road. It is probably deposited by people using and waiting for the bus. The rubbish has been largely cleared away and we are looking into buying a bin, but the regular emptying of that bin will cost several hundreds of £'s per year. Work in progress!

We have been approached by two residents who have expressed an interest in the role of councillor - more on this next month.

Rodney is now retired. It has been my absolute pleasure to work with him here and there and the vote for a new councillor will take place shortly. In the meantime, Claire.critchison@iow.gov.uk is our representative. Rodney is an old school gentleman. Tenacious, approachable and so very dedicated. I would like to wish him the very best of luck in his retirement, and I know he is held in high regard by everyone who has ever had dealings with him. Good luck Rodney.

Finally, sparse though they are, we think that there are the first shoots of the wild flowers poking through at the Rec.
