

Dear Wroxall Parish Council,

Island Roads has informed us you have received a request for the possible implementation of 30mph speed limit roundels to be painted at each entrance to the village. The Authority is in agreement with this request and it has been agreed that one roundel will be painted adjacent to the 30mph northbound terminal sign at the Clarence Road entrance to the village, and one roundel will be painted adjacent to the 30mph southbound terminal sign at St Johns Road, as per the specification and map below:

1 x 7500mm roundel is painted adjacent to the 30mph northbound terminal sign at the Clarence Road entrance to the village, and 1 x 4300mm roundel is painted adjacent to the 30mph southbound terminal sign at St Johns Road



The Authority can confirm that it will pay for the cost of implementing these roundels.'
